

Volunteering and the Country Ambulance Service

Schools

Kindergarten & Pre Primary @ Ravensthorpe DHS

Kindy operates two full days a week and Pre Primary operates five days. The school has two specialist centres to cater for these young students with a play-based learning program that prepares students for formal learning in year one.

Primary School @ Ravensthorpe DHS

Formal schooling starts for students who are six or turning six in the first half of the year. The primary program runs through years 1 to 6.

Primary School @ Hopetoun Primary School

Hopetoun Primary School caters to Kindergarten aged children to year 6 students.

Year 7 students will then go on to Ravensthorpe District High School. A daily school bus service to Ravensthorpe is provided for high school students residing in Hopetoun.

High School @ Ravensthorpe DHS

Students enter this phase in their schooling in year 7 through year 10 (12 to 15 year olds)

Years 11 and 12 can continue here with the School of Isolated and Distance Education (SIDE) or attend Esperance Residential College.

Electoral district

Ravensthorpe is in the Roe State Electoral District and the Federal Electorate O'Connor.

Updating your enrolment

- You are required to enrol for your new address within 21 days of being entitled to be enrolled.
- You are eligible to enrol at your new address once you have lived there for more than one month.

Update your enrolment with the Western Australian Electoral Commission at www.elections.wa.gov.au

Enrolment for Council elections

- If you are a resident or a non-resident owner or occupier of rate-able property in the local government district, you are eligible to vote in Council elections.
- If you are a resident in the Shire of Ravensthorpe and you are enrolled on the State Electoral Roll for your current address, you will be automatically able to vote.
- If you own a property in the Shire of Ravensthorpe but live in another shire, you must apply to be included on the local electoral roll.

The Ravensthorpe Community Swimming Pool is located in the Ravensthorpe District High School grounds - entrance and car park from the old Ravensthorpe-Hopetoun Road.

During the summer months (October to April inclusive), the pool is open to residents and students who are Access Card Holders, from sunrise to sunset. This pool is not supervised by a Life Guard and therefore requires users to pay a minor Membership Fee and undergo safety training (Free Pool Induction) to qualify for access.

The free pool inductions become available to community members prior to the pool opening for the summer. During this time bookings can be made by calling the Ravensthorpe Shire on 9839 0000.

Applications for Access Cards are also managed by the Shire.

Ravensthorpe Gym

The Ravensthorpe Gym is located on the ground floor of the Ravensthorpe Entertainment Centre and Sporting Complex ("The REC"). Gym members have access to the gym 24 hours a day, 7 days a week - so you can work out when it suits you.

There's everything you need in a gym: Top of the range gym equipment for Cardio, weights and strength machines.
